# The Challenge

- The profitability of feed milling is underpinned not only by the cost of raw materials but the efficiency of use of the mechanical/thermal inputs to manufacture a high quality pellet
- Steam conditioning is the most important element in achieving high quality pellets at high production rates at a low cost
- Inefficiencies in steam conditioning may arise when the interphase of steam and mash feed is not optimal

## **Our Solution**

- MY Emul– Vet is a blend of salts of fatty acids, distilled succinylated monoglycerides and mono- and di-glycerides that optimize the physico-chemical interactions during conditioning
- MY Emul Vet has been proven to reduce production costs while improving product quality
- Reduce Production Costs
  - Improve throughput by up to 57% (ton/hr)\*
  - Reduce power consumption by up to 36%\*
  - Increase inclusion of water
  - Increase use of low-cost ingredients
  - Extend use of dies
- Increase Capacity
  - Improve product quality:
  - Fewer fines
  - Less burning
  - Extend shelf-life
  - Increase PDI

## **MY Emul-Vet supports improved feed production** efficiency and quality through:

#### Lubrication

Reduced mechanical friction

#### **Improving Surface Area of Water**

- Improved access to entire feed
- Higher use of water in mash permitted
- Increased drying/cooling rates water binding and ease evaporation of excess moisture
- Lowers Aw leading to better shelf-life

#### **Modifying Starch**

- Improved PDI
- Improved digestibility
